<u>Vision</u>: Gestalt Community Schools' vision is building better communities through education.

<u>Mission:</u> The mission of Gestalt Community Schools is to leverage community assets to empower citizens who will be college-ready, career-ready, and community-ready. Purpose:

At Power Center Academy Middle School – Hickory Hill, we believe that when families are actively engaged in their child's education, scholars thrive academically, socially, and emotionally. Academic Achievement: Enhance scholar learning and academic achievement by involving families in their child's education and providing resources for academic support at home.

Partnerships: Build strong partnerships between the school, families, and the community to support scholar success and well-being.

STRATEGIES + INITIATIVES

Academic Achievement:

• Parent-Teacher Conferences: Conduct regular parent-teacher conferences to discuss scholar progress, set academic goals, and address any concerns. While we encourage parents and teachers to establish a rapport

for constant communication, we have three designated days throughout the school year that will be reserved for school-wide parent teacher conferences.

- Academic Workshops: Offer workshops for parents on topics such as study skills, homework help, and understanding the curriculum.

- Tutoring and Mentoring Programs: Provide opportunities for scholars to receive additional academic support outside of regular school hours. Each teacher must provide tutoring for at least 1 hour per week to scholars who need support the most.

Communication:

- Parent Communication Channels: Establish clear and accessible communication channels for parents, such
 as a school newsletter, website, and social media platforms. We use the following platforms to
 communicate with our families:
 - SwiftK12 Plugin provides opportunities for mass emails to be sent to all parents in our PowerSchool system.
 - o Family Newsletters Parents receive bi-weekly newsletters with our events, activities, important information, and feedback opportunities.
 - Facebook Page We use our school Facebook page to be informative as well as celebrate our school community's achievements in academics and culture.
 - Written Communication/Letters Home: We will use written communication to send home with scholars periodically to provide an additional layer of support.
- Parent Education Sessions: Offer sessions for parents on how to effectively communicate with teachers and advocate for their child's needs. We partner with our network NICE Team (Network of Inclusion, Culture, and Equity) to provide sessions for parents such as ESL Classes for parents, Parent Advocacy training, Communicating with a Middle School Scholar, and more.

Family Support:

- Parent Resource Center: We have reserved a space in our school that serves as a resource center with
 materials and resources for parents on topics such as parenting skills, child development, and academic
 support.
- Family Engagement Events: We organize and implement events and activities that involve families in the school community, such as family nights, workshops, and volunteer opportunities.

- We have Family Engagement Liaisons that are a support for our parents and help to bridge the gap between home and school. Our FELs meet with parents regarding attendance, grades, and other needs or resources (i.e. grief counseling) that may arise.
